## **Abstract Submissions:**

Abstracts of current research or work in progress are welcomed.

## **Abstract Submission Themes:**

Presentations must be grounded in Nursing/Interdisciplinary Health knowledge, and related to students' work in their respective master programmes.

## **Format of Abstract:**

Word limit: 500 words (this does not include the title and author details).

The abstract should not include references.

Please use Verdana or Arial 12 pitch font, single-line spacing, with two spaces between paragraphs.
